





Cloverbud Guidelines for the Fair!

Cloverbud 4-H is a non-competitive learning experience for youth ages 5-6 years old. Cloverbud 4-H members receive participation ribbons, feedback from the judge, but do not receive premiums or participate in the premium auction.


Livestock Sale Participants

NOW is the time to start visiting with supporters for the Premium Auction at the fair. Be sure to thank them for previous support and ask for their continued support of 4-H members' projects.

Brain-storm with your parents—who does your family do business with? Think about your bank, parents' employers, local or regional businesses. If they cannot commit to supporting the auction (or they are providing support in another way at the fair), remember to politely thank them for consideration.

Having an "elevator speech" ready about WHY 4-H is important and HOW it has impacted you are crucial pieces of these conversations.

Additionally, begin thinking about lining up processing slots depending on your species as we don't always have a floor for some areas.



In **Focus on Photography,** youth will focus on equipment basics, taking pictures, the concept of lighting & flash.




In **Controlling the Image**, youth will explore depth of field, aperture and shutter speeds, hard and soft lighting, silos, and flash techniques.

As a reminder for Registered Breeding livestock, including cattle and dairy goats—All entries must be registered in the 4-H member's name BY June 15 of the current year and proof of registration (copy of papers on file) is DUE to the Extension Office BY July 1. If paperwork is not on file and the animal was not tagged during spring weigh-in, the animal will not be allowed to show.
